




## Unique jewellery overflowing with meaning

There are two types of Tamashii<sup>®</sup> bracelet - single loop or double loops. They are gender-neutral and fit any wrist size.

#### CITRINE

The main extraction areas are located in Brazil and in Burma, as in the case of our bracelets.The stone is also known as 'the crying gem' for its alleged capacity to alleviate traumatic experiences through the purification of tears. It helps us open up our mind by stimulating a sense of forgiveness and flexibility. It may also assist those who come into contact with the stone in their efforts to overcome the pain of old wounds, encouraging contact with others and reconciliation.

Essence and simplicity

The Tamashii<sup>®</sup> Ear-Drops collection pays homage to Tārā, the Great Mother Goddess and Protectress of Tibet, and the design of these earrings is indeed inspired by her birth.

On one particular occasion, Avalokiteśvara, the Buddha of great compassion, was unable to save sentient beings as he would have desired and, overcome by terrible despair, he cried. Tārā was born from a teardrop shed by the Buddha and she embodies the very essence of compassion, aimed at eliminating the suffering of all sentient beings and leading them towards a state of enlightenment.

OM TARE TUTTARE TURE SVAHA

She personifies the principle of immediate intervention and symbolises the active and energetic aspect of compassion, which will help us overcome difficulties that arise. Her body, formed by an emerald green light, is radiant, clear and translucent. it is not solid and material, and would appear to oscillate between a dimension of reality and non-reality. The colour green symbolises air (or wind) and, thus, also movement. From the spiritual point of view, the colour therefore indicates enlightened activity and an active, effective form of compassion. Tara intervenes for the good of those who submit their prayers to her, without delay and acting like a swiftly-moving wind. This collection is composed of earrings made from Sterling (925) Silver, with hard, natural gemstones which we love to define as the "drops of compassion" and a drop-pendant necklace.



The symbols of victory over disagreement and quarrels are formed by three mythical creatures. Each symbol presents the union of two parts represented by 'traditional enemies' (i.e., a predator and its prey): the garuda<sup>(1)</sup> and snow lion; the fish and otter; the crocodile and sea snail. Created by the blending of two naturally hostile creatures, the images symbolize victory over discord.
